Attention of the Importers/Exporters/Custom House Agents/General Public and other community partners is invited to the Public Notice No.153/2005 dated 29/11/2005 enclosing Board Circular No.42/2005 Cus dated 24/11/2005 and Public Notice No.75/2006 dated 22/6/2006 regarding the above subject.

In this regard this is to inform that the Accredited Clients Programme (ACP) facility which was automatically extended to the Green Channel Importers to enable them to apply for the Accredited Client Programme and get registered under it, **expires on 31.03.2007**. Thus those importers who are not registered under ACP Scheme will lose the facilities of the Scheme after 31/3/2007. Hence, all importers who are eligible for registration under ACP scheme and have not applied for ACP facility so far, are requested to apply for the ACP Scheme to their respective ports (i.e. ACC/ICD, Bangalore) in the prescribed proforma **on or before 31/1/2007**, failing which the said facility will be withdrawn from 1/4/2007 onwards in respect of the those importers who are not by then registered under ACP scheme.
