Sub :- Conducting of Examination under Regulation 8 of Custom House Agents Licensing Regulation, 2004 on **03.11.2010** & Inviting application for grant of CHA Licenses under Regulation 4 of CHALR'04- Reg.

I. Examination under Regulation 8 of Custom House Agents Licensing Regulation 2004.

As intimated by the Director General of Inspection, New Delhi, the written Examination under Regulation 8 of Custom House Agents Licencing Regulations 2004 will be held **on 03rd November, 2010 (03-11-2010) from 10.00 AM to 1.00 PM**. The venue of the examination will be communicated in due course. The Custom House Agents may sponsor their candidates for the said examination.

2. The persons who are employees, partners or directors of licensed Custom House Agents and nominated by the concerned CHA are eligible to appear for the Regulation '8' Examination as per CHALR-2004. Such nominees should possess the following educational qualification:

Graduate from a recognized University and possessing a professional degree viz. C.A/M.B.A/L.L.B./ Diploma in Customs Clearance work from any Institute or University recognized by the Government with a working knowledge of computers and customs procedures.

OR

A graduate having at least three years experience in transacting Custom House Agents' work as a G-Card holder,

OR

A retired Group 'A' officer from the Indian Custom and Central Excise Service (IC&CES) having a minimum of ten years experience in Group 'A'

Note: Qualifications/Degrees mentioned above are only acceptable and equivalent qualifications are not acceptable.

3. The persons working with the Courier Companies engaged in electronic filing and processing of customs declarations with regard to import and expor consignments currently functional for courier clearances at palces viz., Ahmedabad

Bangalore, Kolkata, Chennai, Cochin, Delhi, Mumbai and Trivandrum may also appear in this examination.

4. All the applicants have to possess the requisite qualifications under Regulation 6 of CHALR' 2004 on the date of submission of their applications.

5. All the applicants who intend to take the examination may submit their applications giving their particulars in the enclosed Proforma (along with recent passport size photograph and photocopy of CHA licence) so as to reach this office on or before **6.00PM of 08.10.2010.**

6. Attested copies of documents in support of qualification(s) should be enclosed with the applications.

7. The applications received after the last date will not be considered for the above examination and no further correspondence in the matter will be entertained.

8. The successful applicants for the written test should also appear for an oral test to be held subsequently. A candidate, who clears the written examination but fails in the oral examination linked to it, shall have to clear the oral examination within two years of the related written examination irrespective of the number of chances, and if he fails to do so, he shall be treated as having failed in the examination. Candidates who appeared for the tests earlier and have failed to clear the written test or oral test are not eligible to appear after 7 years from the date of their first appearance.

9. Information regarding Roll Nos and seating arrangements would be displayed on the notice board of the Commissionerate in due course. The application should be furnished in the prescribed format which is enclosed as Annexure to this notice, for each of the candidates separately, along with the photocopies of the qualification certificates as detailed at Para No.2 above, which are duly attested by the licensee himself and the Gazetted Officer from Customs Department.

II. Application for grant of CHA license under Regulation 4 of Custom House Agents Licensing Regulations 2004 who have qualified in Examination conducted under Regulation 8 of CHALR'04.

1. Applications are invited for grant of New Customs House Agent licenses in terms of Regulation 4 of the Customs House Agents Licensing Regulations, 2004 (CHALR, 2004) by Bangalore Customs Commissionerate.

2. An application for a license to act as a Customs House Agent in Bangalore Customs Commissionerate shall be made in the form of letter to the Commissioner of Customs, Bangalore containing details as specified in Form "A" of CHALR 2004 (enclosed) and shall, inter alia contain the name and the address of the person applying and

i) if the applicant is a firm -

- a) the name and address of every partner of the firm, the firm's name and
- b) the name of the partner or the duly authorized employee, who will actually be engaged in the clearance of goods or conveyance through the customs

ii) If the applicant is a company

- a) the name of each director, managing director, manager and

b) the names of director, managing director, manager or the duly authorized employee, who will actually be engaged in the clearance of goods or conveyances through the customs

3. The applicant referred to in clause (b) of para 2(i) and 2 (ii) above, as the case may be **shall be a person who has passed the examination referred to in regulation 8 of CHALR, 2004** from Bangalore Customs Commissionerate and shall prove to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Customs, that he fulfills the conditions specified under regulation 6 of CHALR'04.

4. The applicants who qualify for grant of a license under regulation 9 of CHALR'2004 shall be required to submit the following before the license is actually granted.

- i) A Bond in Form D (Specified in CHALR 2004) and a surety bond in Form E (Specified in CHALR 2004) for due observance of these regulations as per Regulation 10 of CHALR,04
- ii) A Bank guarantee / postal security or national savings certificate in the name of the Commissioner of Customs, Bangalore for an amount Rs.75,000/- for carrying out of a business as a Customs House Agent as per Regulation 10 of CHALR' 04.
- iii) CHA license fee of Rs.5,000/- paid in TR - 6 challan as per Regulation 9 of CHALR' 04
