A post of Inspector in the pay band of Rs.9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4200/- is likely to fall vacant in the Office of the Competent Authority & Administrator, SAFEMA/NDPSA, Mumbai. The post is to be filled up on deputation / absorption basis from amongst the eligible and willing officers of Central Government.

Eligibility :

Deputation or Absorption :

- (i) Inspector of Income Tax or Customs or Central Excise or Narcotics (Central Bureau of Narcotics or Narcotics Control Bureau) or Assistant Enforcement Officer or Sub-Inspector of Police, Central Bureau of Investigation ; or
- (ii) Head Clerks or Tax Assistants or Upper Division Clerks of Income Tax, Central Excise and Customs Departments who have qualified in the Departmental Examination for promotion to the grade of Inspector in the respective Departments. Officials with flair for Income Tax Act, Customs Act, Foreign Exchange Maintenance Act and Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act will be given preference.

The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment on deputation shall not exceed 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of application. The selected candidates will have the option to draw the existing pay with deputation allowance or pay in the new pay scale, if selected to a higher post.

Bio-data of the eligible and willing officers may be called for and forwarded to this office by 14.09.2010 positively alongwith vigilance clearance and ACR gradings for the last five years.
